Here are a few best practices for connecting your LinkedIn account to LinkedIn Learning:

Sign in to the account directly from LinkedIn.

Example: If you have a personal LinkedIn account, you can connect it to your LinkedIn Learning account. However, if you have a company LinkedIn account, you cannot connect it to your LinkedIn Learning account.

Keep your LinkedIn account secure. Use a strong password and enable two-factor authentication. This helps protect your account and the data in it.

Once you connect your LinkedIn account to LinkedIn Learning, you can access your LinkedIn Learning account from the LinkedIn Learning app.
