

Then, click on the "run declared problimetresset December Description of the degree Audit to load. Once it is loaded, click the "printer friendly" button in the top right and save the audit as a PDF. Once saved, upload it to Handshake within the "Documents" section of the printer friendly.

#### Should You Accept Your Summer Offer or Keep Interviewing?

If you had a positive summer experience and are satisfied with the offer, it's wise to accept. Campus recruiting will likely extend beyond your decision deadline, but remember: you know more about your summer job than any new offer, so accepting carries less risk. Many students who delay accepting and would invited the first original offer.

#### Considerations for Declining

Holding multiple offers can take opportunities from classmates and reflects poorly on both you and your school.droweione considerievalaldifferent industry, it's better to decline and strategize your job search. Don't settle for a job you're not excited about—your hard work deserves better. Be prepared to put effort into your job search, leveraging resources like alumni networks and beyond campus recruiting.

#### Reneging an Offer
